The 2022/23 season was full of GROWTH! This growth showed up in a variety of ways at the TGC - including staffing, membership, and programming - and none of it would have been possible without your partnership.

Membership numbers increased to prepandemic levels with an added benefit of new and innovative programming. The staff worked hard to ensure every girls' voice was heard and that programming remained relevant, powerful, and full of joy! The community engagement programming grew through a new partnership with the Lapan Sunshine Foundation, and we launched the TGC's Early Childhood Music Program to serve the littlest singers and musicians in our community.

The growth at the TGC couldn't have been completed without the addition of fiercely talented staff and committed staff members that have expanded their roles at the TGC. Exciting shifts include Jess Edelbrock as Director of Operations, Nicky Manlove as Community Engagement Director, and Brandi Dignum as Director of Education. The expansion of the staff is a testament of the growth and impact the TGC has on our community. It also aligns with the Board of Directors' commitment to invest in people, the TGC's vision to create more access to music, and our strong conviction that music, especially singing together, has the power to transform lives.

The TGC also remains committed to increasing the funding of scholarships and engaging programming to those who might not otherwise have access.


