AT TGC, OUR MISSION has always been to build girls' confidence and character, create a sense of belonging, encourage leadership, and affirm that their voices matter. As we grow, that mission has expanded into changing the world through the power of music. With ambitious goals for the future, we remain rooted in our values: accessible and nuanced singing for women and girls of all ages, singer-led programming, leadership development, and fostering meaningful relationships.

OUR 2023-24 SEASON was a flourishing success, both in programming and community engagement. We proudly expanded to over 370 talented singers, including babies and toddlers, from 35 different zip codes. We awarded scholarships to 108 deserving young musicians and provided subsidized programming in partnership with school districts to five Title I schools. Our Mariposa and Jubilate Choirs represented TGC with performances outside our city and state at the highest levels. This past June, we were thrilled to bring our Advanced Choir and Alumnae members on a tour to Spain and Portugal, where we performed to enthusiastic audiences.

AT TGC, GIRLS' VOICES RESONATE far beyond the concert halls. They contribute to board strategic plan meetings, staff artistic plan discussions, and, just as importantly, within each rehearsal space. Together, we lead and build the future of our organization. Our work transcends music, emphasizing personal development, community building, and using music as a powerful tool to nurture self-worth, foster belonging, and inspire civic engagement.

YOUR UNWAVERING SUPPORT ensures that these young voices are not only heard but celebrated, *helping to build brighter futures*. Thank you for being an essential part of this inspiring journey.




