

The TGC's programming is funded by membership fees, administrative support, and ethical fundraising in both Central, East, and Northwest locations. Through multiple partnerships, the TGC's Engagement program extends the many benefits of singing to our broader community. We are committed to transparency and fiscal responsibility, and are grateful to the community's collaborations that help to ensure sustainable programming.



TGC REACHES DEEP

Our K-12 singers meet weekly at 3 locations and 6 partner schools to work together toward *musical excellence and affirmation that their voice matters*.

We are so proud that 96% of TGC parents report a noticeable increase in their singers of at least one mission-based characteristic: self-confidence, acceptance of others, responsibility, increased appreciation for music, and/or sense of belonging.





TGC REACHES WIDE

In order to ensure access to music education for all, TGC's Community Engagement and Music Educator Support Programs focus on removing barriers.

Through efforts aimed at increasing music teacher recruitment and retention, *TGC* serves 55 music educators and over 3,000 students per year across 38 zip codes.






The TGC is governed by a dedicated group of volunteer board members. We thank them for their time and talents to help lead and set a strategic vision of growth for our girls!

The music was challenging, but the beauty and sense of unity I felt singing with my choir will stay with me forever. Through my experiences with TGC, I learned discipline, responsibility, and the power of teamwork.

The TGC also gave me the world. I went on 6 tours, including 3 international ones. The Advanced Choir tour to China in my senior year sparked a love for the country that led me to study abroad and even live there later in life. TGC gave me the courage to face new experiences with curiosity and excitement.

Even now, years later, I carry the TGC with me, in my music, in my career in the nonprofit world, and in the **values of connection and service** that continue to shape who I am. The friendships, the lessons, and the magic of singing together remain a part of me, always.
